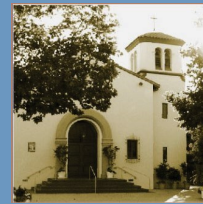

CLERGY CORNER

The following is from the Detailed Rules for Monks by St. Basil the Great, bishop:

Love of God is not something that we can be taught. We did not learn from someone else how to rejoice in light or want to live, or to love our parents or guardians. It is the same, perhaps even more so, with our love for God: it does not come by another's teaching. As soon as the living creature... comes to be, a power of reason is implanted in us like a seed, containing within it the ability and the need to love. When the school of God's law admits this power of reason, it cultivates it diligently, skillfully nurtures it, and with God's help brings it to perfection.

Since this is so, we can say the same about love. Since we received a command to love God, we possess from the first moment of our existence an innate power and ability to love... It is natural for us to want things that are good and pleasing to the eye, even though at first different things seem beautiful and good to different people. In the same way, we love what is related to us or near to us, though we have not been taught to do so, and we spontaneously feel well disposed to our benefactors. What, I ask, is more wonderful than the beauty of God? What thought is more pleasing and satisfying than God's majesty?

The radiance of the divine beauty is altogether beyond the power of words to describe.

Are you a registered parishioner?

If you are over the age of 18 and attend mass here regularly, we encourage you to register as a member of Our Lady Star of the Sea Church.

Here are five main reasons why registering is important:

- ◇ Gives us the opportunity to welcome you to our community.
- ◇ Sometimes there are occasions where letters of recommendations are needed from the pastor (immigration, catholic school enrollment, scholarships, legal matters, etc.). **If you are not registered, we cannot provide a letter for you or your family.**

- ◇ Helps us to communicate directly with our parishioners.
- ◇ Allows our parishioners the option to receive donation envelopes.
