The holy season of Lent has begun! It is a sacred time in which we strive to be more intentional about living our Catholic faith. We embrace discipline through fasting, charity through almsgiving, and holiness through prayer. During the next few weeks, we have several opportunities to help us on our journey, both as individuals and as a community. Our Lenten dinners are held every Friday (March 22 and 29, and April 5 and 12), from 5:00 to 7:30pm. This is a wonderful way to be a part of our community and to enjoy one another's presence, plus the food is great as well! Following the Lenten dinners, at 7:30pm, we will pray the Stations of the Cross in the church, in both English and Spanish. The Sacrament of Confession will also be available at the usual time, on Fridays from 6:30-7:30pm. In addition, I am providing extra times for receiving this sacrament. The schedule is as follows: Mondays (March 18 and 25, April 1, 8, and 15) from 7:00-7:45am; Wednesdays (March 27, April 3 and 17) from 5:30-6:15pm; Thursdays (March 21 and 28, April 4 and 11) from 7:00-7:45am; and Fridays (March 29, April 5 and 12) from 7:00-7:45am. You can also make an appointment for another time. Lastly, on Thursday, April 4, we will have a special Lenten Mission, beginning at 7:00pm. Think of it as a 90-minute retreat, in which we will pray together, and I will give a talk entitled, "The Cost of Discipleship." I hope you take advantage of these opportunities, and I hope you have a blessed and fruitful Lent. **In Christ's mercy,** *Fr. Robby*
