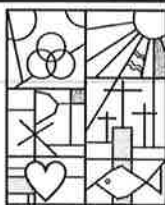

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION Registrations for our programs will be Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 3pm – 7pm during the month of July ONLY. Please come prepared with your documents and the registration fee of \$80. The programs we provide and documents needed are:

First Communion - this is a two year program for children between the ages of 7 (or starting 2nd grade in the fall) and 12. Documents needed are birth and Baptism certificates.

Confirmation - this is a two year program for teens between the ages of 14 (or starting freshman year of high school in the fall) and 16. Documents needed are birth, Baptism, and First Communion certificates.

Adult Confirmation/RCIA - this is a one year program for people 18 and older that need Baptism, First Communion, and/or Confirmation. Documents needed are birth certificate and certificates for the sacraments that have been received. For any question please call the office at (831) 429-1018.
